

Lottery Policy

When & Where Lottery Will Be Held

The lottery will be held on Wed, Feb 15, 2023 at KIPP Chicago's regional office (2007 S. Halsted).

Who Can Be Present During The Lottery

Members of the public, including parents and representatives from CPS, may be present.

How Students Will Be Selected

All applicants have an equal chance at admission via the lottery. However, per the Illinois School Code, priority shall be given to siblings of pupils enrolled in the charter school and to pupils who were enrolled in the charter school the previous school year:

- a. All students who were enrolled at the end of the previous school year will automatically be re-enrolled. They do not need to complete an application.
- b. Siblings are defined as students who share at least one parent.
- c. For multiple births (e.g., twins, triplets), parents complete one application to ensure that siblings remain together throughout the lottery process.
- d. All siblings of pupils currently enrolled will be given a "lottery priority" code of 1 in PowerSchool Registration (our web-based enrollment management system), and after the lottery is run, all students with a code of 1 will be at the top of the waitlist.
- e. All siblings of pupils applying will be given a "lottery priority" code of 2 in PowerSchool Registration, and after the lottery is run, all students with a code of 2 will be below students with a code of 1 and above students with a code of 3.
- f. All students who have no siblings attending or applying will be given a "lottery priority" code of 3 in PowerSchool Registration, and after the lottery is run, all students with a code of 3 will be below students with a code of 1 or 2.

How & When Parents Will Be Notified Of Admittance/Waitlist Status

All students will be notified via e-mail and/or letter of their status—selected or waitlisted—within 3 weeks of the lottery. Students who have been selected must begin registration either in person or online within 48 hours of acceptance. For students who do not begin registration in a timely fashion, the office staff will follow up with all phone numbers listed on the application to offer a final chance to enroll before the student is removed from the selected list.

How School Generates Waitlist, Selects Students, & Notifies Families Of Students Admitted From Waitlist

The waitlist is generated by PowerSchool Registration based on the priority codes mentioned above. When a grade level has an opening, an office team member moves the next student on the waitlist to the selected list and then contacts the family via phone/text/e-mail/letter, following up if multiple times if necessary. The school's waitlist for a particular school year is maintained throughout the school year. A family not selected from the waitlist for a particular school year will need to re-apply for the next year's waitlist.

How & When CPS Will Be Provided With A Video Of Lottery

The lottery will be videotaped by KIPP Chicago Schools' Managing Director of Operations, and the file will be uploaded to Epicenter.
